DEMETRA SFENDONI-MENTZOU is Professor Emerita of Philosophy of Science at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki-Greece (A.U.Th.), and the founding President of the Interdisciplinary Centre for Aristotle Studies (DI.K.A.M.), of A.U.Th. She was educated at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and Oxford University (Recognized Student for graduate studies 1975-77). She received her Ph.D. from A.U.Th. (1980, cum laude). Among the scholarships/awards she received are the following: British Council Scholarship for post-graduate studies, Oxford University (1976-77); Visiting Research Scholarship of the British Council, Oxford University (1986); Erasmus Research Award, Universities of Oxford and Cambridge, UK (1990); Fulbright Senior Visiting Scholarship, Harvard University (1991); she was also one of the ten Greek nominees for the "Woman of Europe" award, 1987, sponsored by the Council of *Europe*. Demetra Sfendoni-Mentzou is teaching for a period of over four decades at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and for a period of time at York University, Toronto, Canada. She has lectured at several Universities in Canada, Germany, Italy, the U.S.A., the UK, and the Netherlands, and participated as an invited speaker in International Conferences in Belgium, Brazil, Canada, China, South Corea, Croatia, Greece, Italy, Poland, Portugal, Russia, Spain, and the U.S.A. Her research and teaching fields of interest are: Philosophy of Science, Theory of Knowledge, Charles S. Peirce, and Aristotle, and she specializes in Aristotle's Philosophy of Nature, proposing a Neo-Aristotelian perspective on Science. She has published a large number of essays on her research fields of interest. Her books as author and/or editor include: *Proceedings of the World Congress "Aristotle 2400 Years"* (A.U.Th. & DI.K.A.M., 2019), *Aristotle – Contemporary Perspectives on his thought. On the 2400th Anniversary of Aristotle's Birth* (De Gruyter, 2018), *Le Temps chez Aristote* (Vrin-OYΣIA/OUSIA, 2016), *Aristotle Today: Perspectives of Aristotle's Philosophy of Nature and Contemporary Physics* (in Greek, ZITI, 2010), *Philosophy of the Sciences*, Vols. I. & II (in Greek, ZITI, 2008), *Aristotle and Contemporary Science*, Vols I. & II (Peter Lang, 2000 & 2001).

Demetra Sfendoni-Mentzou has been the principal supervisor of 23 completed MAs, 7 completed PhDs and 3 completed Post-Docs, and the principal investigator of fifteen research programs mainly on Aristotle and contemporary Science. Her academic activities also include organizing a large number of Colloguia, Seminars, Round Tables, Cultural Activities, International Conferences, and Congresses, most notably: the 23rd World Congress of Philosophy, (co-vice president), Athens 2013; World Congress "Aristotle 2400 Years," (President), Aristotle University of Thessalonikiancient Mieza-ancient Stageira, May 23-28, 2016; International Conference, "Aristotle and Contemporary Physics," (President), co-organized with CERN, A.U.Th., 2014; Pan-Hellenic Conference, "Philosophies of Science" (President), A.U.Th., 2006; International Conference "Aristotle and Contemporary Science" (President), A.U.Th., 1997. Currently, she is a member of the Steering Committee of the "Aristotle-Confucius Symposium" on Ethics for the 21st Century," which will take place in Athens and Thessaloniki (July 3-8, 2023) and responsible for organizing the Thessaloniki-ancient Stageira-ancient Mieza portion of the Symposium. She has also been appointed as co-chair of the session, "Greek, Roman, and Byzantine Philosophy," of the 25th World Congress of *Philosophy,* to be held in Rome-Italy, August 1-8, 2024, under the theme "Philosophy" across Boundaries."

Demetra Sfendoni-Mentzou has served as President of *the Greek Philosophical Society*, 2006-8. During her presidency the candidacy of the *Greek Philosophical Society* won the decision of the General Assembly of FISP to organize the 23rd World *Congress of Philosophy in Greece* (Athens, 2013), for the first time since 1900; she has also served as President of the *Charles S. Peirce Society* (CSPS, 2014-15). During her presidency, the CSPS organized, in collaboration with the *Peirce Foundation*, the *"Charles S. Peirce International Centennial Congress"* (University of Massachusetts Lowell, July 2014). Demetra Sfendoni-Mentzou has served thirteen times as President of the Association of *Fulbright Scholars of Northern Greece*, and –since 2011 up to the present– as the founding President of the *Interdisciplinary Centre for Aristotle Studies*, of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece.
