Tomás Calvo Professor of Philosophy at University of Complutense (Spain)

Professor Tomás Calvo studied at the Universidad Complutense (Madrid, Spain) where he became Philosophy Doctor in 1972.

He was Fellow of the *Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas* (Madrid, 1965), the *Juan March Foundation* (1971-73), and the *Center for Hellenic Studies* (Harvard University, in Washington D.C., 1975-76).

He became Full Professor of Philosophy at the Universidad de Granada (Spain) (1981-95), and after this he moved to the Universidad

Complutense (Madrid) where he has occupied a permanent Chair on Greek Philosophy from 1995 on.

He has been Invited Professor and has lectured in several Universities in Europe as well as in Latin America (Argentina, Chile, México, Brasil).

He has translated Aristotle into Spanish and commented on him (*De Anima, Metaphysics*), and he has written books on Plato and on Aristotle, as well as many articles on Greek Philosophy in several languages.

He has been President of the International Plato Society (IPS) (1992-95), of the Sociedad Ibérica de Filosofía Griega (SIFG) (2000-2012), of the Institut International de Philosophie (IIP) (2008-2011).

At present he is Honorary President of the *Sociedad Ibérica de Filosofía Griega (SIFG)* and of the *Institut International de Philosophie (IIP)*. He is also *Correspondant de l'Institut de France (Académie des sciences morales et politiques)*.
